

Land Registry Terms of Use

You must not:

- (a) alter the layout or design (including font, type size, notes and headings) of the form; you may for the purposes of customising the form for any matter on which you are advising amend the precedent clauses;
- (b) use an out of date form: You should ensure that the form is the current version at the time of use and it is advised to check on the Land Registry's website that the form is still the current version;
- (c) store any form in precedent format or re-use any amended form as a precedent;
- (d) remove the Crown Copyright acknowledgement and reference located on the form; or
- (e) permit anyone who is not authorised to use Practical Law to use the form (or any part thereof) whether in digital or printed format other than your clients in respect of a specific matter in which the form is being used.
